

ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION PLAN

The legal authority of the Board is to be transmitted through the district administrator along specific paths from person to person as shown by organizational charts for the district (Policy CCA). The lines of authority in the charts represent direction of authority and responsibility. All such charts shall be regarded as visual representations of policy.

The Board recognizes that good management underlies the success of all organizations. The Board further recognizes that open communication and involvement in decision-making processes whenever possible is also essential in effective organizations. For those reasons the district administrator and the Board shall establish and maintain effective relationships between administrators, faculty and staff (Policy CCB).

The administrative organization plan shall use a management team approach. The management team shall consist of the Board, district administrator, and building principals. The management team approach calls upon the skills of individual team members to work together for the common purpose of improving the effectiveness and efficiency of the school district.
