

## BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board shall act as a committee of the whole, except for the following standing committees:

Support Staff Negotiation Committee  
Teacher Negotiation Committee

The Board President shall appoint standing committees annually after receiving preferences from individual Board members. All standing committees shall consist of no more than three members. The first named person shall act as chairperson. Standing committees shall report to the Board following each committee meeting or when requested by the Board President.

At the request of the Board, the Board President shall appoint ad hoc committees comprised of less than the full membership of the Board for special purposes. The Board President may also appoint ad hoc committees if the need arises. The number of members appointed to each ad hoc committee may vary, but will include at least two Board members. The first named person shall act as chairperson. Ad hoc committees shall hold meetings in accordance with established procedures and shall be discharged on completion of their assignments.

The district administrator shall serve only in an advisory capacity to all standing and special committees of the Board. Committees shall have no power to take action or to commit the Board or district to any course of action, except as specifically directed by the Board. They may act only in an investigatory and advisory capacity.

Public notice shall be given for all Board committee meetings in accordance with state law and established procedures.
