

## BONDUEL CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS PROGRAM

The School District of Bonduel recognizes the value of teacher participation in staff development activities. The purpose of the Bonduel Continuing Education Credits Program (BCECP) is to encourage and recognize teachers for participation in programs that the District develops or provides as well as those offered through CESA's, universities, and other state organizations that enhance pedagogy.

### The following criteria will be used to determine program approval:

1. BCECP programs are staff development programs developed by the District or its representatives (CESA) and that are offered outside of the contracted calendar year (after 3:30, weekends, and during the summer). Programs offered by other organizations may be submitted for consideration on an individual basis to the Staff Development Council.
2. The BCECP program has been approved by the DPI for re-certification credit.
3. All BCECP programs must be pre-approved by the Staff Development Council or its designee.
4. Any programs for which you do not receive personal compensation or salary schedule advancement may be eligible. Programs such as the Eisenhower or Mini-grant programs are ineligible as the participants receive stipends and/or credit.
5. All programs must have direct classroom application.

### Teachers may apply to the District Administrator for one of the following options:

1. Teachers who have attended pre-approved programs that do not count toward salary schedule advancement and have attended 15 hours of BCECP programs will be allotted:
  - a.) up to \$100 to purchase related classroom instructional materials; or
  - b.) a release day to plan for implementation of strategies introduced in the workshops. This day will be developed with the approval of the building principal.

This allotment encourages/supports teachers to implement the knowledge that they have gained while attending district-approved workshops and/or conferences.
