

CURRICULUM REVISION CYCLE

The curriculum revision schedule reflects a 6 year cycle for curriculum and textbook revisions and purchase. The schedule provides for the revision of one major core curriculum area per year with the exception of Year 1. Vocational education and Tech Prep initiatives continue to expand the need for a K-12 emphasis in this area.

Computer education, environmental education, gender equity, education for employment, and career development objectives will be integrated into the existing curriculums listed below.

1. Textbook purchases must be authorized by both the building principal and Director of Curriculum & Instruction to prevent the purchase of textbooks out of sequence.

Curriculum writing will be scheduled in June whenever possible to provide staff with a large block of uninterrupted time for inservicing on curriculum, discussion of current research practices within the curriculum revision area, time for interaction and discussion of methodologies and classroom practices.
