

SELECTION OF  
VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN POLICY

The Valedictorian and Salutarian of each graduating class will be determined as soon as semester grades are official and incomplete grades are finalized, following the completion of the first semester. The selection will be based upon the following:

1. Valedictorian and Salutarian will be declared based upon the highest and next highest percentage cumulative grade point average.
2. A minimum of four semesters of academic work through Bonduel High School is required for eligibility (e.g. continual enrollment beginning with the second semester of the sophomore year).
3. A candidate for Valedictorian or Salutarian must be a full-time student enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits per year.
4. All Bonduel High School courses in conjunction with transcribed and dual enrollment course work through post-secondary institutions will be included in the grade point determination with the exception of driver's education and work credit program(s). Post-secondary courses taught by staff other than Bonduel High School instructors will not count towards a student's GPA.
5. Students with equal average cumulative grade points will be declared Co-Valedictorians and Co-Salutarians.
