Responsibilities of LEA Representative include representing the school district regarding the development and review of Individualized Education Program (IEP) plans. At least one LEA Representative must be present at each IEP Team meeting when an IEP is being developed, reviewed, or modified.

Wisconsin state statutes define the LEA Representative as a staff member who:

- is qualified to provide or supervise the provision of specially-designed instruction to meet the unique needs of children with disabilities
- is knowledgeable about the general curriculum
- is knowledgeable about the availability of resources by the LEA

The Director of Pupil Services will ensure that an administrator serves as LEA Representative at meetings which require district financial obligation decisions.
