

Naming Facilities

The naming of school buildings and facilities is the responsibility of the school board.

It shall be the general policy of the school board not to name buildings and facilities of the School District of Bonduel after individuals or groups.

The district's four school buildings are officially designated as:

Bonduel Elementary School
Bonduel High School and Middle School
Cecil Elementary School
Navarino Elementary School

Should the board determine that an overwhelming desire exists in the community to name a building or facility, the board president -- upon authorization of the board -- shall appoint a facility-naming committee consisting of two citizens of the district, two teacher representatives, one administrator, a student, and not more than two board members. The committee will recommend to the board for their consideration no more than three names in order of preference. The board will make the final selection from the list submitted by the committee.

The facility-naming committee shall observe the following guidelines in developing the name list:

- a. The name should be easily identifiable with the facility.
- b. The name should not be in conflict with the names of other facilities in the district.
- c. The name should have significance for people using the facility.
- d. If the facility is to be named after a person, that person shall be of exemplary moral character, have made an outstanding contribution to education, humanity or community, or have displayed outstanding leadership, be a person of historical significance, been retired for a minimum of five years, or deceased a minimum of one year.
