

Title I Program - Family Involvement

In order to provide educational opportunities for all students of the district, the Board shall participate in the federal Title I program.

The Board recognizes the importance of parent and teacher involvement in the Title I program and will provide appropriate opportunities for parents and teachers to become involved in the design and implementation of the District's Title I program. Specific activities for parent and teacher involvement in the District's Title I program shall include:

1. An annual meeting for families of participating students to explain Title I requirements and parental rights.
2. An annual planning meeting to enable Title I parents to participate in evaluating current year programs and to help plan program modifications for the coming year.
3. Family-teacher conferences in conjunction with district parent-teacher conferences in addition to parental conferences as needed.
4. Opportunities for families of Title I students to observe Title I program activities.
5. Title I staff readily available for meetings with families to discuss any concerns that might arise about student progress, program goals or the school curriculum as it relates to the Title I program.

All programs and services provided to Title I students shall be at least comparable to those provided in areas not receiving Title I funds. Also, the District shall ensure equivalency among schools or grade levels within the District in teachers, administrators, auxiliary personnel, curriculum materials and instructional suppliers. When determining comparability, the District shall not consider unpredictable changes in student enrollment or personnel assignments that occur after the beginning of the school year.
