

STUDENT SUSPENSION

The district administrator, or any principal or teacher designated by the administrator may suspend any pupil for a time not to exceed three days for any of the following reasons of misconduct:

1. Noncompliance with the rules and regulations of the school.
2. Knowingly conveying any threat or false information concerning an attempt or alleged attempt being made or to be made to destroy any school property by means of explosives.
3. For conduct by the pupil while at school or while under the supervision of a school authority which endangers the property, health or safety of others at school or under the supervision of school personnel.

Suspension Procedures

1. Prior to any suspension the student shall be advised of the reason for the proposed suspension.
2. The student may be suspended if guilty of any of the above types of misconduct.
3. The parent or guardian of a minor suspended student shall be given prompt notice of the suspension and the reason for the suspension.
4. The suspended pupil or the suspended pupil's parent or guardian may, within 5 school days following the commencement of the suspension, have a conference with the district administrator or his or her designee who shall be someone other than a principal, administrator or teacher in the suspended student's school.
5. Reference to the suspension on the student's record will be erased, if the district administrator or his or her designee finds that:
 - a. the pupil was suspended unfairly or unjustly, or;
 - b. the suspension was inappropriate, given the nature of the alleged offense, or;
 - c. the student suffered undue consequences, or penalties as a result of the suspension.
6. A suspended student shall not be denied the opportunity to take any quarterly, semester or grading period examinations missed during the suspension period.

Suspensions may be continued for not more than ten days if an expulsion hearing has been scheduled (Policy JGE).
