Exciting Happenings for our Youngest Bonduel Bears! 3K, Birth to Five Playgroup, and Before and After School Program

Our 3K program is going strong, offering a wonderful no cost all day, everyday program for our youngest Bonduel Bears! We only ask that your child is potty trained and turns 3 years old by September 1st! Our youngest Bears learn to be comfortable in the school environment and work on social emotional skills as well as pre-academics through our Tools of the Mind curriculum. This month we are wrapping up our Home unit and preparing for our Grocery unit. Embedded in their dramatic play centers, students are exposed to sequencing, sorting, literacy, and turn taking. Our 3K students are also learning self regulation skills during our Freeze Dance, with some awesome dance moves, and pre-writing skills during Graphics Practice.



We are also excited to announce our new Before and After School Child Care Program that started in September! Bonduel Elementary School is offering Before and After school childcare for children ages 3 - 12 (as of September 1, 2023), beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. The program operates from 6:30 - 7:50 a.m. (before school) and 3:04 - 5:30 p.m. (after school). The Before and After School Childcare program will operate on the same days as the school calendar. The cost is \$3 per hour. As we move into October, we can report that everything is going great! Thank you to the parents for supplying Ms. Paape with schedules and using the app for messaging and billing. If anyone has questions or problems with the app to let her know at childcare@bonduel.k12.wi.us or 715-758-4950 ext. 600. Ms. Paape also wanted to reach out to parents if they are cleaning toys out their children's closets for the preparation of Christmas and want to donate gently used toys to the aftercare program, we would greatly appreciate them. Ages 3 and up. We will also share with the other 3K and 4K classrooms. Highly wanted items are a dollhouse with furniture/people and tractors. Items can be dropped off at the Before and After Care Door. This way we can swap out toys when the students get bored with what we have.

Finally, our Little Bears Play Group and Child Find is in session again this year! Play Group happens one Friday every month from 8:30 – 10:00am for children ages birth to 5 years old and their caregivers. A snack is provided along with an art activity, songs, and a story. It is a wonderful opportunity to introduce the school setting to children and make connections with other caregivers! The Play Group also functions as the district's Child Find program, so if any family has speech or developmental concerns for their child ages 3-5 years, they can let us know and we can have a speech pathologist, occupational therapist, physical therapist and/or special education teacher attend Play Group and talk with you about your concerns.

The 3K and Play Group Programs are available to any family in the surrounding area. You do not need to live in the Bonduel School District to participate. For our Before and After Child Care Program, you do need to have a student enrolled in the Bonduel public schools.
