Bonduel is located in northeastern Wisconsin approximately 25 miles west of Green Bay and 35 miles north of Appleton and the Fox Valley. Shawano is located 7 miles west of Bonduel and Shawano Lake is 5 miles north. The Bonduel School District is rural district with a strong agricultural base encompassing an area of 156 square miles in Shawano County with a total population of 5,300 people.

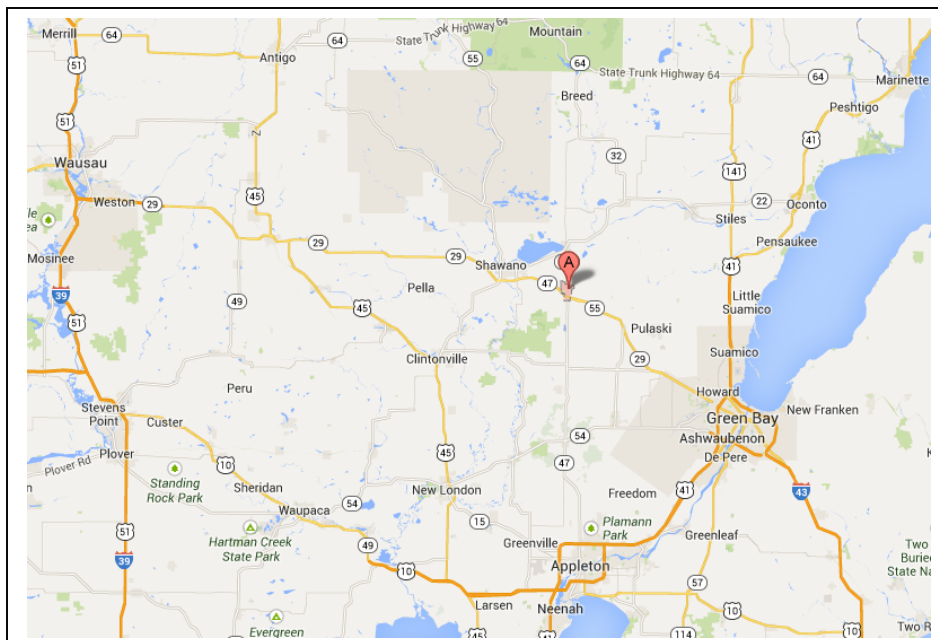
