

JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: ART SUPERVISOR

Qualifications: Department of Public Instruction certification in art education with a minimum licensure of K-6.

Reports to: Elementary Principal

Job Goal: To develop in each pupil an interest in and the ability for expressing himself/herself creatively in visual terms, utilizing skills, and techniques of artistic expression appropriate to the student's interests and abilities; to develop aesthetic understandings and appreciations; to discover and develop talents of students in the field of art.

Basic Function: Supervise the K-6 art education program.

Responsibilities:

1. Supervise art education classes in grades K-6 when taught by the classroom teacher.
2. Provide specific lesson plans to accomplish the objectives stated in the art education curriculum guide when lessons are taught by the classroom teacher.
3. Meet with classroom teachers upon request or as needed.
4. Serve as consultant and/or resource specialist for the K-6 staff who teach art.
5. Provide art materials and equipment to classroom teachers when they are responsible for teaching the art lesson.

Evaluation: Performance of this job will be evaluated annually by the elementary principal.
