

Bonduel School District Special Education Policies and Procedures

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), local education agencies are required to establish written policies and procedures for implementing federal special education laws. In addition, Wisconsin law requires local education agencies to establish written policies and procedures for implementing state and federal special education requirements. The School District of Bonduel will adopt the Department of Education's *Model Local Education Agency Special Education Policies and Procedures* in order to meet this requirement.

The revised model policies reflect the changes in state and federal law that have occurred as a result of the reauthorization of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and Chapter 115, Subchapter V, of the Wisconsin Statutes.
