

STUDENT ADMISSIONS

It shall be the responsibility of the parent or guardian of each child or a student of legal age entering the School District to complete official registration forms prior to assignment by the principal to a grade or schedule of classes.

Students transferring from other school systems are required to provide a transcript of academic accomplishments at their previous school, or the address from which this data may be obtained (refer to Policy JECB). Students entering the school district from a home-based private educational program or private school shall be required to provide any available academic information and may be required to take appropriate academic tests to assist in making a placement (refer to Policy JECA).

Parents or guardians of students admitted to the district's elementary and secondary schools shall present immunization records as required by law (refer to Policy JHC).

The School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
