

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The school district shall provide transportation for students, residing within the school district boundaries, as required by State Statutes and the provisions of this policy.

The transportation director shall be responsible for the daily operation and administration of the transportation system. The transportation director shall be the liaison between the transportation staff and the district administration as well as serving as the initial contact for parents and residents with transportation concerns. Additional duties and responsibilities of the transportation director are listed in Policy CDAC.

The transportation director shall insure the safe operation of all district owned vehicles through regular routine maintenance, repair work by nondistrict employees, bus driver training inservice, and monitoring bus driver licensing. The transportation director, with the assistance of the building principals, is responsible for student discipline and conduct on district-owned vehicles. Bus drivers share responsibility for student safety and good conduct and are required to apply bus rider rules as listed in student handbooks and Policy EEACC in a fair and consistent manner.

The goals of all district transportation policies is safe operation of vehicles and safe transportation passengers. Transportation Services Management policies provide guidelines to accomplish these purposes.
