REGISTRATION

- Registration is Due May 10, 2019. Registration may be turned in after the due date; however, you are less likely to get the classes of your choice.
- If your child is in Pre-4K, Pre-K, or Post-K those classes are all morning one session only classes.
- Register for classes for the grade your child is in today! Children in 1st-6th grade choose a 1st and 2nd choice from each session, and number your choices #1 and #2. If their first choice is full, the student will be put in the class of their second choice. This is on a first come, first serve basis. Please understand that we will do everything we can to try to give your child the choices they want. Due to limited class sizes this may make it hard to accommodate each child.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

The Bonduel teachers and staff work very hard to provide a safe and fun learning environment for students. Summer school is a great learning opportunity and privilege. Students need to understand their behavior must meet the same expectations given during the normal school year. Pre-4 Year Old Kindergarten For Children Who are Entering 4K

(Age 4 by September 1, 2019)

We will spend the morning preparing for attending 4K IN FALL. We will learn social skills, appropriate school etiquette, become familiar with Bonduel Elementary School building. Your child will listen to stories, make crafts, play indoors and on the play-ground. Your child should bring a backpack and change of clothes daily.

Pre-Kindergarten For Children Who are Entering Kindergarten

(Age 5 by September 1, 2019)

We will spend the morning working on reading, math, science, social studies, music and art! Students will spend all morning in Pre-Kindergarten. Come and join us for a lot of fun! If you register for this class, you do not need to register for any other sections.

Post-Kindergarten For Children Who are Entering First Grade

(Age 6 by September 1, 2019)

We will spend the morning working on reading, math, science, social studies, music and art! Children interested in attending this class must have attended kindergarten during the 2018-2019 school year. Please remember to send your child with a backpack daily! If you register for this class, you do not need to register for any other sections.



Class Descriptions

Hour of Code (Offered to grades 1-5)



Why learn Coding? "This year, almost 200 million students around the world were exposed to coding through the Hour of Code event" - let's continue learning!!! In this class you will learn the basics of computer coding. Students will learn how to program their own interactive stories, games, and animations. Coding drives innovation, allows the students to be creative and builds confidence. Let's get coding!!!

Puzzles and Games (Offered to grades 1-6)

Are you ready to have some fun playing games and solving puzzles? In this class, we will build friendships as well as math and language skills while enjoying new and familiar board games, such as *Uno*, *Apples to Apples*, *Spot It*, and *Bananagrams*. We will also work on problem-solving skills by learning how to solve different types of puzzles, like Suduko and Cryptograms.

Tap and Ease on Down the Road with Mrs. Sorlie! (Offered to grades 1-6)



Looking for a little exercise, a lot of laughs, and some dance instruction this summer? Come to this class to learn some tap and jazz sprinkled with an occasional Polka (hey, it's the official state dance, right?) and other party dances. You'll be ready to bust a move at the next wedding celebration! We'll even learn *The Alligator*, and we'll have to test Mr. Grayvold's knowledge about that dance! We need some boys to help us with the theatrical parts of the dances, so don't be shy!



The tap dance will be performed to *Stuck Like Glue* by Sugarland. The jazz dance will be to *Ease on Down the Road* by Diana Ross (The Wiz soundtrack). We would like to perform our dances near the end of summer school, so stay tuned for more information as that time comes nearer!

Please wear comfortable clothing with tennis shoes or socks for this class. Please try to have tap shoes for your student. Please consider reaching out on social medias to borrow a pair that suits your child. If you don't find a pair, please do not let that keep you from this class. We'll make do! This class is limited to the first 20 hard-working students.

Fun with Science! (Offered to grades 3-6)

Explore various science topics through inquiry and exploration. We will be doing hands on activities daily to discover how science is all around us.



Wildlife Expedition (Offered to grades 1-6)

The wild provides us with a lot to explore. Do you want to check it out? Explore your wild side, learning about habitats, ecosystems and different types of animals as we take an expedition right in your own backyard! Students will have the opportunity to investigate animal habitats, hike through the woods and go on a week long camping trip, along with a variety of wildlife related activities. Tennis (Offered to grades 1-6)



Come learn the game of tennis! You will gain fundamental skills, strategies, and have fun! All levels of play are welcome. You will learn how to: hit a forehand, backhand, serve, and play the net like a pro. We will play competitive games, move our feet, and enjoy the outside summer weather!

Summer Fitness (Offered to grades 1-6)

Students will work on improving their fitness levels in cardio, flexibility, and strength. We will use our pedometers for long walks and jogs, our stability balls to improve our core strength, and our medicine balls and stretchy bands to increase our arm strength. Tag games we play will also increase our cardiovascular fitness!

Adventures in Bookland! (Offered to grades 3-6)

Are you a kid that loves to read but doesn't have time or a quiet place to do that? This is the class for you! We will spend our time lounging in comfy chairs or on blankets outside, curled up with a good book. I will help you choose books if you need help with that or you can bring books that you want to read from home. We will also make two walking trips to the Bonduel Library (card required if you want to check out books).



So join me for 5 weeks of comfy, quiet reading time during Summer School!

Minecraft for Beginners (Offered to grades 1-6)

Welcome to the world of Minecraft! This computer game allows players to craft, build, and use their imagination in this 3-D procedurally based world. In this summer school class, we will learn how to craft, create, and build many different objects in this open world game. Beginners will learn the basics of the game including how to play, how to create diverse resources, how to craft various armors, and build different buildings they see all around the world.

Minecraft (Offered to grades 1-6)

Welcome back to the world of Minecraft! This computer game allows players to craft, build, and use their imagination in this 3-D procedurally based world. In this summer school class, students who already have a pretty good handle on how to play Minecraft will be using their prior knowledge of the game to interact with others students to craft, build, and create many diverse objects and buildings. Students will be given projects to work on as well given a direction each day. The students will not just be coming to class to play a game as the class will be interactive and using lots of team work.



Language Love! (Offered to grades 1-6)

Take the bummer out of summer with *Language Love!* In this fast-moving class, you'll explore cognates (those lil' pieces of words that have special meaning), learn Spanish, and American Sign Language. Get ready for friendly competitions like Around the World, Quizlet Live, and Kahoot! Plus, you will have the opportunity to read to young children each week. So, get your brain ready to sponge up some knowledge and your hearts ready to share the love of language!

Project-Based Learning (Offered to grades 3-6)

What is PBL? In this class, you'll explore real-world and community problems as a class, and then (in teams), problem-solve to find solutions to help remedy some of those problems. In your teams, you'll need to figure out what resources you would need and the timeline that you are tethered to make this world a better place! So, could we make plans to visit some lonely citizens in our area...maybe perform a skit there? Or, does our school woods need clean-up? Can we collaborate with another school using technology to start a Recess Buddy program at our schools? These are the types of ideas that YOU, the students, will brainstorm and tackle in your teams. Don't let me (Mrs. Sorlie) tell you what to do. It's your time to make this world a better place!



Fun With Math (Offered to grades 1-6)

Students will work their way through basic math facts, place value, telling time, money, fractions, and measurement skills this summer. Each week will be centered around a different skill using hands on activities. Technology will be incorporated weekly. Students will enhance their knowledge of math skills and strategies. Finally, daily math practice will provide maintenance of math concepts explored.

3-D Arts and Crafts: (Offered to grades 1-6)

If you love making things with your hands then this is the class for you! In this art class, we will be exploring various techniques in art to create one-of-a-kind crafts. We will be: weaving, sculpting, paper making, beading and so much more! This class is a great way for you to be creative and create amazing works of art you will get to bring home. Cooking (Offered to grades 3-6)

In this section, you will learn to make fun, easy, meals, snacks, desserts and more. You will also learn how to make foods for breakfast, lunch, and dinner!

Growing Healthy (Offered to grades 3-6)

Do you like to get your hands dirty? Would you like to learn about and plant different vegetables and flowers? Would you like to go strawberry picking and learn how to preserve them for eating in the winter? If you would like to find out the answers to all these questions join us for "growing healthy". We will be engaging in fun and hands on activities each day while learning about growing plants and vegetables. If this sounds exciting to you come join us for a fun summer school class!

Advanced Fiber Arts (Not for Beginners) (Offered to grades 4-6)

Fiber art is a creative process using many textiles, such as yarn, or fabric. We will be weaving pot holders, sewing pillows, cross stitching, making tied-died T-shirts, yarn bowls, and so much more. The Great Outdoors! (Offered to grades 2-5)

Interested in spending more time outside and connecting with nature? In this course, we will use our senses to connect to the forest. We'll have fun in natural areas. Everyday (that it's not raining) we will spend time outside, being mindful of the world around us. Let's explore and discover the Great Outdoors!



Lego Robotics: (Offered to grades 3-6)

Creation with Legos is as limitless as your imagination allows, but how would you like to test that? By programming Lego creations using Lego Education's award-winning WeDo robotics and programming software, your imagination can stretch even further by bringing your creations to life! Coding, engineering, and problem-solving is just the start to this class. Once we've built and programmed our bots, we start experimenting with them. If we want our robot to move in a certain direction, or make a sound, or make a different motion, how do we program them to do that?
