BEHAVIOR POLICY

Class Descriptions

Puzzles and Games (Offered to grades 1-4)

Are you ready to have some fun playing games and solving puzzles? In this class, we will build friendships as well as math and language skills while enjoying new and familiar board games, such as Uno, Apples to Apples, Spot It, and Bananagrams. We will also work on problem-solving skills by learning how to solve different types of puzzles, like Sudoku and Cryptograms.

Fun with Science! (Offered to grades 3-4)

Explore various science topics through inquiry and exploration. We will be doing hands-on activities daily to discover how science is all around us.

Fun In the Sun! (Offered to grades 1-4)

In this class students will be learning about and participating in outdoor games. We will be doing group activities and using our imagination while having fun in the sun. If the sun isn't out or is too hot to play, we will be learning and playing indoor games.

K'Nex Stem Academy (Offered to grades 2-4)

If you like theme parks you will love this class! In this course students will create and design our own theme park utilizing K'Nex theme rollercoasters, ferris wheels, and much more. This course will also help students develop critical thinking skills, problem solving skills, physical dexterity, fine motor skills, and spatial awareness. Creating with Knex using three-dimensional objects also enables students the ability to plan ahead and make the necessary alterations so the pieces fit together as intended. And don't forget, it's the science involved that makes K'Nex really fun; the build-up potential energy on the hills, kinetic energy on the drops, acceleration and g-forces on the loops and turns that get your blood pumping and adrenaline flowing!

Fun in Fitness (Offered to grades 1-4)

Love to be active and learn new games both in the gym and outside? This course offers lots of movement with tagging exercises, lifetime activities, backyard games and free play! This class will help improve your skills as well as give you a new background on classic games such as 4 square, rock climbing and more!

Cooking (Offered to grades 2-4)

Calling all Chefs! Do you like to cook? Then this is the class for you! In this section, students will get hands-on experience in the kitchen learning how to make easy and fun recipes!

Fun and Healthy Habits (Offered to grades 1-4)

Love getting to play, learn, and eat healthy food? In this class, students will get to learn healthy habits when it comes to exercise, food intake, and in class game play! Each student will get to try one new food each week for our "Tasty Tuesday" trying out new snacks like smoothies, avocados, dragon fruit and more!

Grow With Us in the Garden! (Offered to grades 1-4)

Join us this summer as we learn about plants and how they grow. We're going to get our hands dirty planting, nurturing, and growing in the BES garden along with a lot of hands-on activities. We will be growing without soil, learning what conditions are best for growing, learning about different crops that we are growing in our garden, sample some veggies that you may not have tried before, and some garden craft projects. We will give you ideas for your own gardens that you can do at home, even if you don't have room. This class will give you many experiences with both vegetable and flowering plants as well as many take home projects. It's going to be so much fun!!!

It Takes a Village (Grades 1-4)

Our community is filled with many wonderful people who have so much knowledge. This class will invite special guests to share their knowledge, passion, and special skills with us. What are your interests, hobbies, goals, talents, and passions? We will discover and talk about these. Would you like to know more about small engine repair, how to change oil or a tire, or what jumper cables are used for? How to better care for our pets. How to start saving for that special car you want to buy or the college you want to attend. Sew on a button, yes you will learn how to do that and more. We will also talk about empathy, compassion, respect, and what it really means to be kind. Come and join this new summer school class. As the saying goes, "If we know better, we do better!".

Minecraft (Offered to grades 1-4)

Welcome to the world of Minecraft! This computer game allows players to craft, build, and use their imagination in this 3-D procedurally based world. In this summer school class, students who already have a pretty good handle on how to play Minecraft will be using their prior knowledge of the game to interact with other students to craft, build, and create many diverse objects and buildings. Students will be given projects to work on as well as given a direction each day. The students will not just be coming to class to play a game as the class will be interactive and using lots of teamwork.

Great Outdoors (Offered to grades 1-4)

Do you LOVE Christmas? Do you wish it lasted longer? Then you will love having Christmas in July! In this class, we will pick a new country each week to focus on. We will learn about their holiday traditions, make crafts, and even sample tasty holiday treats from around the world! If you love celebrating holidays, you will love Christmas in July!

Crafty Creations (Offered to grades 1-4)

A fun and exciting summer arts and crafts class for students, where imagination knows no limits! With plenty of hands-on activities, students will express themselves and create crafts to take home. The class is all about crafting, building confidence, and exploring imagination while experiencing the joy of creating art.

Dance Camp (Offered to grades 1-4)

This dance camp is full of spirit! Participants will play dance games, warm up to upbeat music, stretch, and learn basic techniques and performance skills. Over the course of the class, dancers will learn choreography and showcase their work in a final performance.

<u>Little Chefs' Summer Kitchen (Offered to Grades 1-2)</u>

A fun and hands-on summer cooking class designed for young chefs. Students will explore basic kitchen skills, learn simple and delicious recipes, and discover the joy of cooking through creative, age-appropriate activities. Each session includes cooking, tasting, and a sprinkle of food-themed fun!

Band Lessons

Summer lessons will be offered during summer school on a pull-out basis during the summer school day. Any student going into grade 5 and up is eligible for lesson time during the summer school weeks. Students entering fifth grade in fall and interested in band are encouraged to take summer lessons (however, lessons are not required - students can start in fall). If students do not take summer school, the lessons times are still available.

- Near the top of the page, click the **Summer School 2025 registration** and complete the registration forms (please complete the registration forms for each child you have attending).
- Once registration is completed, along the left-hand side, click on **Arena Scheduling**. (If you have more than one student, chose from the drop-down menu).
- On the top of the page, under "period" use the drop down and select "1".
 - * You will **not** need to select anything from the "subject" drop down.
- Then click "apply filter". This will show you all the course 1 offerings. When you have decided which course you would like, click the add button on the left of the course name.
- Move back up to the top of the page, under "period" use the drop down and select "2".
- Repeat the same process as above until you have added an offering for session 1, 2 and 3.
 - * Please be aware that you can only sign up for a course for one session. Scheduling the same course more than one session will result in the school choosing a replacement course.
 - * Students should not sign up for more than 1 session of Minecraft or take both Grow with us Garden and Advanced Gardening. Advanced Gardening class is geared toward students who have already taken a gardening class from previous years.
