## **Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Board President Dennis Bergsbaken at 7:07 p.m. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance were administrators, staff, and members of the public.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Nate Burton for approval of Minutes of the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025, Regular Meeting. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Voucher approval of checks numbered 114332 through 113376 for the period of 10/30/25 through 11/12/25 in the amount of \$180,730.81 and an ACH payment of \$4,175.31. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Co-curricular voucher approval of checks numbered 32317 through 32320 for the period of 10/30/25 through 11/14/25 in the amount of \$521.27. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the resignation and the new hires as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Dave Bohm to approve a Board Meeting Date change from January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026, to January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and from January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026, to January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2026. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Dave Bohm for Approval of Resolution for the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction to grant an exemption for the School District of Bonduel to begin the 2026-2027 school year prior to September 1, 2026, for the purposes of providing required instructional minutes, providing staff with an appropriate level of professional development, and to provide students with the greatest chance for academic success. The motion carried 7-0.

In discussion, administrator Joe Dawidziak discussed and looked for feedback regarding a potential referendum survey, mill Rate/levy comparables and District/School Report Cards.

In the District Administrator's Report, Joe Dawidziak updated the Board on an upcoming Wellness Committee event, the likelihood of the creation of a grade 5-12 student Wellness Committee, and an increase in cost related to District participation in Esports.

In the Elementary Principal's Report, Mrs. Groeneveld discussed the positive results of standards based report cards tied to recent Parent/Teacher conferences, Fall student reading plans finishing up on Friday, upcoming events related to making cookies, Reader's Theatre, the result of a

recent, very successful Food Drive that will help local food pantries, and the upcoming 3K concert, Book Fair, and PTO Santa Shop.
