Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Board President Dennis Bergsbaken at 7:00 p.m. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance were administration, staff, and members of the public.

A motion by Nate Burton was seconded by Dave Bohm for approval of Minutes of the February 2nd, 2026, Regular Board Meeting, the Minutes of the February 5th, 2026, 5:00 p.m. Special Meeting, and the Minutes of the February 5th, 2026, 6:30 p.m. Special Meeting. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Voucher approval of checks numbered 114702 through 114767 for the period of 1/28/26 through 2/11/26 in the amount of \$107,642.53 and ACH payments of \$176,700.56. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Co-curricular voucher approval of checks numbered 32334 through 32335 for the period of 1/30/26 through 2/11/26 in the amount of \$896.80. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Nina Rouse to approve the new hires as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

In discussion, administrator Joe Dawidziak gave updates on enrollment, Senior Breakfast, the 2026-2027 District Calendar, and Transportation Bids.

In the District Administrator's Report, Joe Dawidziak discussed upcoming weekly architect meeting, a scheduled day for architects to meet with staff on Tuesday, February 24th, a survey to go out to staff on March 20th to potentially be followed with a community survey, and upcoming meetings with NEOLA and CESA 8.

In the Elementary Principal's Report, Mrs. Groeneveld discussed student/staff shortages due to illness, celebration of the 100th day of school and the opening Olympic Ceremony and a related scavenger hunt, , the attendance of 4K at their first assembly, a phonics update, a Tema Tally Rally for positive behavior that includes a "Bears Can" form, 4K having a fancy dinner recently, the upcoming arrival of Tom Pease and musical sessions, no school on February 27th, a literacy update with minimal changes to student personal plans, the upcoming Book Fair in March, the upcoming field trip to Bay Beach on June 1st, and getting ready for Forward testing soon.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken to adjourn to closed session as authorized under Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(c) for the purposes of considering employment,

promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. The motion carried 7-0.
