**Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Board President Dennis Bergsbaken at 7:00 p.m. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance were administrators, staff, and members of the public.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Nate Burton for approval of Minutes of the February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026, Regular Meeting. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Voucher approval of checks numbered 114768 through 114811 for the period of 2/12/26 through 2/24/26 in the amount of \$55,531.88 and no ACH payments. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Greg Borowski was seconded by Nina Rouse for approval of Request for Bids for Construction Management. The motion carried 7-0.
