Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Administrator Joe Dawidziak at 7:00 p.m. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance were staff, administration, and members of the public.

In Board Reorganization, the Election of Officers was as follows:

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the Designation of Official Depository for District Funds as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Dave Bohm to approve the Messenger as the Designation of Official District Newspaper. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the Designation of Date, Time, Place and Number of Regular Monthly Meetings as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the Annual Meeting Date as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Julie Felhofer to approve Dennis Bergsbaken as the 2026-2027 WASB Delegate and Nate Burton as the Alternate. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Dave Bohm for Dale Bergsbaken to serve as the CESA 8 Representative/Delegate. The motion carried 7-0.

In Public Appearances, Somerville presented a document to be reviewed and used in an upcoming Board Workshop and answered questions accordingly. There was also a request made to update the Middle School Curriculars and Extracurricular portion of the District website and there was a question regarding the continued publication of 3K registration.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Julie Felhofer for approval of Minutes of the April 20th, 2026, Regular Meeting. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Voucher approval of checks numbered 114972 through 115028 for the period of 4/16/26 through 4/28/26 in the amount of \$77,638.20 and ACH payments in the amount of \$3,809.31. The motion carried 7-0.

In discussion, administrator Joe Dawidziak gave an enrollment update and discussed details regarding the upcoming Board Workshop.

In the District Administrator's Report, Joe Dawidziak discussed an update to the website including the SRO officer, an Alumni project taken on by a student, the last senior breakfast of the school year, the upcoming Goody Duathlon, Community Service day, and a recent building use request.

In the Food Service Directors Report, Betsy Stanke discussed a change with 5th grade breakfast, upcoming field trips, a recent 50% increase/upcharge for fuel from vendors, and upcoming changes and questions regarding requirements to lower salt and sugar.

In the Maintenance Directors Report, Butch Froemming discussed the business of April and May, the recent Elementary Spring Concert and set up for Graduation.

In Board President Report and Other Board Member Correspondence, Dale Bergsbaken relayed a recent conversation regarding the success of the senior citizen breakfast program.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Nate Burton to adjourn to closed session as authorized under Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(c)(f) for the purposes of the consideration of personnel and as authorized under Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(c)(e) for the purposes of considering or discussing issues pertaining to compensation of certified, noncertified and administrative staff. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Nate Burton to reconvene to open session. The motion carried 7-0.
