The meeting was called to order by Board President Dennis Bergsbaken at 7:09 p.m. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance were administration, staff, and members of the public.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Dave Bohm for approval to deviate from the order of the items on the agenda, moving item 8b (Asphalt/Parking Lot) to the beginning of the agenda. The motion carried 7-0.

In discussion, a representative from an asphalt company presented information to the Board and answer questions.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Ashley Pearce for approval of Minutes of the Regular Meeting on May 18th, 2026. The motion carried 7-0.
