Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Board President Dennis Bergsbaken at 7:00 p.m. All Board members were in attendance. Also in attendance were administrators, staff, and members of the public.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for approval to deviate from the Order of the Items on the Agenda, moving item 8b (scholarship Committee Presentation) to the beginning of the agenda. The motion carried 7-0.

In Discussion, Raquel Strayer, on behalf of the Scholarship Committee, presented information regarding the Committee processes, members, bylaws, etc., and answered questions.

A motion by Nate Burton was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for approval of minutes of the July 20th, 2026, Regular Board Meeting. The motion carried 7-0.

In Public Appearances, detailed concerns were mentioned regarding the possibility of adding another section of 4th grade for the upcoming school year, suggestions regarding the communication for Athletic meetings containing more detail, specifically which sports and their associated grades being included in the messaging, and consideration being given to prioritizing Seniors for scheduling classes in the future.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Voucher approval of check numbered 115297 through 115315 for the period of 7/16/26 through 7/30/26 in the amount of \$49,108.53 and ACH payments in the amount of \$316.52. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Dave Bohm to approve the staff resignation as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Nate Burton to approve the staff hire as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the Seclusion and Restraint Report as presented. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Greg Borowski was seconded by Julie Felhofer to approve the Resolution authorizing the District to borrow the sum of not to exceed \$2,500,000 as a Taxable Revolving Line of Credit that can be drawn upon and repaid in any amount/or at any time during the term of the loan provided no draw after July 31st, 2027, Pursuant to Section 67.12(8)(a)1, Wis. Stats. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the NEOLA Policy Special Update Act 89, First Reading. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Greg Borowski was seconded by Julie Felhofer to approve the NEOLA Policy Special Update Act 89, Waive Second Reading. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Julie Felhofer was seconded by Dave Bohm for approval of Out of State Travel Request: National FFA Convention. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Julie Felhofer to approve the 2026-2027 Employee Handbook. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken to approve the Foreign Exchange Student Permission. The motion carried 7-0.

In Discussion, administrator Joe Dawidziak gave a brief preview of the upcoming Annual Meeting to take place on August 17th, 2026.

In the District Administrator's Report, Joe Dawidziak updated the Board on recent community trail activity, a recent CESA 8 PAC meeting, response to the publication of the District Residency statement, the upcoming new staff orientation, and Graduation.

In the MS/HS Associate Principal's Report, Ms. Hintz thank the maintenance/cleaning crew, the excitement of the new staff orientation coming up, and updates to the Mentor Handbook.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken to adjourn to closed session as authorized under Wisconsin Statue 19.85(1)(a) for the purposes of the consideration of personnel and as authorized under Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(c)(e) for the purposes of considering or discussing issues pertaining to compensation of certified, noncertified, and administrative staff. The motion carried 7-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Greg Borowski to reconvene to open session. The motion carried 7-0.
