Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Board President Dennis Bergsbaken at 7:00 p.m. All Board members were in attendance, with the exception of Julie Felhofer and Dave Bohm, who arrived at 7:30 p.m. Also in attendance were administrators, staff, and members of the public.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Greg Borowski for approval to deviate from the Order of the Items on the Agenda, moving item 8b (Tax Bill Explained) to the beginning of the agenda. The motion carried 5-0.

In Discussion, administrator Joe Dawidziak presented a rough draft of a document explaining tax bills and fielded concerns, questions, and suggestions from the Board and various members of the public.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Nina Rouse for approval of minutes of the December 15th, 2025, Regular Meeting. The motion carried 6-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Voucher approval of checks numbered 114500 through 114588 for the period of 12/11/25 through 1/7/26 in the amount of \$139,162.32 and ACH payments of \$201,432.37. The motion carried 6-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Dale Bergsbaken for Co-curricular voucher approval of checks 32324 through 32326 for the period of 12/11/25 through 1/7/26 in the amount of \$3,121.80. The motion carried 6-0.

A motion by Greg Borowski was seconded by Nina Rouse to approve the resignation and the retirement as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

A motion by Dave Bohm was seconded by Greg Borowski to approve the staff hires as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

A motion by Dale Bergsbaken was seconded by Nina Rouse to approve the Architect Hire (Somerville) as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

In discussion, administrator Joe Dawidziak discussed enrollment and open enrollment and the very high likelihood that the School District of Bonduel will be accepting zero students in all grades and in Special Education for the 26.27 school year when formally decided upon at the next Board meeting.

In the District Administrator's Report, Joe Dawidziak discussed the upcoming Senior Citizen Breakfast, recent discussions about the possibility of a rock climbing group, the mirroring of the 3K application process to the open enrollment window, answering tax questions at an upcoming

Town of Washington Board Meeting, and the revocation of open enrollment status for three students due to truancy.

In the Elementary Principal's Report, Mrs. Groeneveld discussed upcoming AimsWeb testing and the positivity of preliminary Kindergarten scores, and upcoming Craft event, attendance at the most recent Little Bears play group event, Mrs. Schwitzer's upcoming Yeti Spaghetti and Reindeer Reader's Theatre events, detailed information regarding upcoming Teacher inservice, Mrs. Salerno's upcoming Gingerbread house building event, and the upcoming Elementary Spring Concert taking place on Friday, April 24th at 1:30 p.m.

A motion by Nate Burton was seconded by Nina Rouse to adjourn to closed session as authorized under Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(c) for the purposes of considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. The motion carried 6-0.

A motion by Nate Burton was seconded by Greg Borowski to adjourn to Open Session. The motion carried 6-0.
