Academic and Career Planning, or ACP, is a student-driven, adult supported process in which students create and cultivate their own unique and information-based visions for post-secondary success, obtained through self-exploration, and the development of career management and planning skills. The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (http://dpi.wi.gov/acp) in the Pl26 legislation requires public school districts to provide academic and career planning services to students in Grades 6 through 12 beginning in the 2017-2018 school year. These new academic and career planning requirements connect school districts' education for employment plans and programs to the new academic and career planning requirements.

In the School District of Bonduel, we are proud to be implementing Academic and Career Planning. We have always had ACP in place, but now it's more formalized for all. ACP is a 4-part process of KNOW, EXPLORE, PLAN, AND GO which students develop throughout Middle School and High School. It is an integral part of our Comprehensive School Counseling conferencing model.
