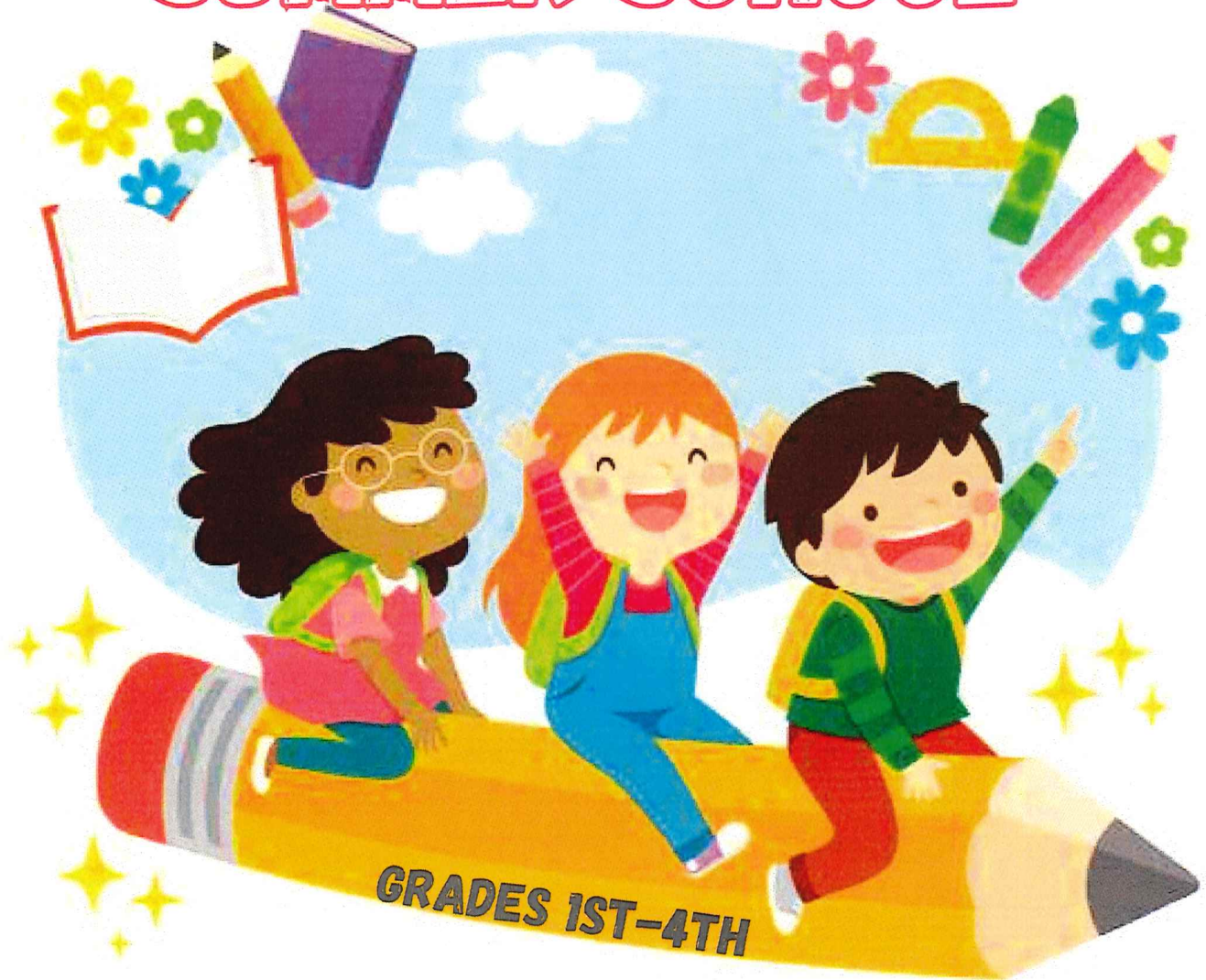

REGISTRATION

Registration closes on May 1, 2026 - No late registrations will be accepted!

When filling out registration, please make sure you fill it out as complete as possible (front and back). It is important we have all information because this is what the office and busing us for the summer school program.

Register for classes for the grade your child is in today! Children in 1st-4th grade choose 8 choices, and number your choices #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, and #6 etc. Students will be put in their first 3 choices, if their choices are full, the student will be put in the next available class of their next choice etc. This is on a first come, first serve basis. Please understand we will do everything we can to try to give your child the choices they want. Due to limited class sizes this may make it hard to accommodate each child.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

The Bonduel teachers and staff work very hard to provide a safe and fun learning environment for students. Summer school is a great learning opportunity and privilege. Students need to understand their behavior must meet the same expectations given during the normal school year. Our staff understands there are times when students need redirection for their behavior. However, numerous redirections, or a serious offense will be directed to the summer school administrator. The administrator will inform parents of this offense and determine the appropriate consequences, which may include a removal from all summer school activities.

If there are any changes for afternoon busing or pick up, please call the elementary office by 11:00am, so there is enough time to notify the teacher.

Class Descriptions

It's Time to Play the Game in Play Lab (Offered to grades 1-4)

In this class, we will play many card, board, and other kinds of games. Some are just mostly luck, but many others involve some strategy. Some are for two players, some are for four, and we will also have a few tournaments where you will get to play against every other student in the class (and maybe the teachers too). Some of the games we will play include Mancala, Connect Four, Checkers and Chess, Yahtzee, and Cribbage. So come join the fun, and GET IN THE GAME.

Fun with Science! (Offered to grades 2-4)

Explore various science topics through inquiry and exploration. We will be doing hands-on activities daily to discover how science is all around us.

Fun In the Sun! (Offered to grades 1-4)

In this class students will be learning about and participating in outdoor games. We will be doing group activities and using our imagination while having fun in the sun. If the sun isn't out or is too hot to play, we will be learning and playing indoor games.

Fun in Fitness (Offered to grades 1-4)

Love to be active and learn new games both in the gym and outside? This course offers lots of movement with tagging exercises, lifetime activities, backyard games and free play! This class will help improve your skills as well as give you a new background on classic games such as 4 square, rock climbing and more!

Cooking (Offered to grades 2-4)

Calling all Chefs! Do you like to cook? Then this is the class for you! In this section, students will get hands-on experience in the kitchen learning how to make easy and fun recipes!

Grow With Us in the Garden! (Offered to grades 1-4)

Join us this summer as we learn about plants and how they grow. We're going to get our hands dirty planting, nurturing, and growing in the BES garden along with a lot of hands-on activities. We will be growing without soil, learning what conditions are best for growing, learning about different crops that we are growing in our garden, sample some veggies that you may not have tried before, and some garden craft projects. We will give you ideas for your own gardens that you can do at home, even if you don't have room. This class will give you many experiences with both vegetable and flowering plants as well as many take home projects. It's going to be so much fun!!!

Great Outdoors (Offered to grades 1-4)

The wild provides us with a lot to explore. Do you want to check it out? Explore your wild side while learning about habitats, ecosystems, and different types of animals right in our own backyard! Students will have the opportunity to investigate animal habitats, hike through the woods, and spend time being mindful of the world around us. Let's explore and discover the Great Outdoors!

Minecraft (Offered to grades 1-4)

Welcome to the world of Minecraft! This computer game allows players to craft, build, and use their imagination in this 3-D procedurally based world. In this summer school class, students who already have a pretty good handle on how to play Minecraft will be using their prior knowledge of the game to interact with other students to craft, build, and create many diverse objects and buildings. Students will be given projects to work on as well as given a direction each day. The students will not just be coming to class to play a game as the class will be interactive and using lots of teamwork.

Read It and Eat! (Offered to grades 1-4)

Get ready for a summer adventure where stories come to life and flavors fill the air! We will be diving into an exciting book together, enjoying delicious treats inspired by our reading, and then bringing the story to life by creating a fun, hands-on craft. It's the perfect mix of imagination, creativity, and tasty fun!

Crafty Creations (Offered to grades 1-4)

A fun and exciting summer arts and crafts class for students, where imagination knows no limits! With plenty of hands-on activities, students will express themselves and create crafts to take home. The class is all about crafting, building confidence, and exploring imagination while experiencing the joy of creating art.

Little Chefs' Summer Kitchen (Offered to Grades 1-2)

A fun and hands-on summer cooking class designed for young chefs. Students will explore basic kitchen skills, learn simple and delicious recipes, and discover the joy of cooking through creative, age-appropriate activities. Each session includes cooking, tasting, and a sprinkle of food-themed fun!

Oh My Golly...Origami (Offered to Grades 2-4)

Origami is the Japanese art of folding paper into fun and decorative shapes and figures. In this class, we will first learn basic folding techniques and bases. We'll then make lots of cool things such as a candy dish (with chocolate kisses to put inside), a dog, a butterfly, a star, and a rabbit. During the class, we will also read the story, "Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes" and then learn how to fold the traditional peace crane. Towards the end of the class, we will learn about modular origami, which is folding several pieces of paper the same way (modules) and then putting them together to create 3-D objects such as a fortune cookie, an octahedron, and a 12-piece wreath.

Band Lessons

Summer lessons will be offered during summer school on a pull-out basis during the summer school day. Any student going into grade 5 and up is eligible for lesson time during the summer school weeks. Students entering fifth grade in fall and interested in band are encouraged to take summer lessons (however, lessons are not required - students can start in fall). If students do not take summer school, the lessons times are still available.
