

# Bonduel Elementary School Supplies List

## 4K Supplies

Every Student:

- 1-Child scissors (Please label)
- 2-Pocket folders (Please label on the outside) (Plastic folders hold up the best)
- 1-Backpack (Normal size, no wheels) (Please label)
- 1-Old oversized t-shirt for painting (Please label on tag)
- 2-Boxes of snack to feed 20 kid students
- 1-Set of extra clothes (Pants, shirt, underwear, socks) (Shoes if possible) (Place clothes in a large Ziploc bag and label bag)
- 1-Beach towel for rest time (Please label)
- 1-Reusable shopping bag (Please label) (The towel will be stored in this bag)
- 1-Pack of thin black dry erase markers

## Class A (Monday, Wednesday and the 1st and 3rd Fridays of the Month):

- 1- Box of tissues

## Class B (Tuesday, Thursday and 2nd and 4th Fridays of the Month):

- 1-Bottle of glue (4oz)

  - 3-Wide lined notebooks (1 yellow, 1 green, 1 purple)
  - 1-Composition notebook
  - 1-1 inch Binder with front and back cover pockets
  - 1-Dry Eraser
  - 1-Set of headphones

  - \*Optional: Water bottle (to have at desk for water)
